DR. RICHARD MARKIEWICZ, CARDIOLOGIST

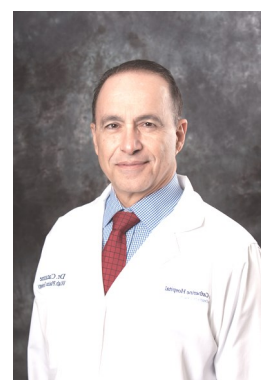


Dr. Markiewicz will return to the Rawlins County Health Center Specialty Clinic on September 19th.
