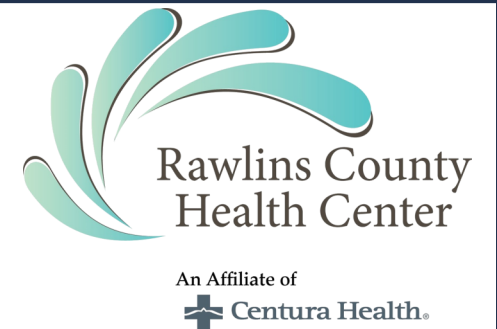

WOUND CLINIC RECEIVES 2 AWARDS

Rawlins County Health Center has been presented with two outstanding achievement awards from Restorix Health. The **Clinical Distinction Award**, which is presented to wound centers that demonstrate exceptional success by meeting or exceeding national clinical and safety benchmarks, including:

- Days to Heal: 32 median
- Healing Percent: 90%
- Patient Safety: 98

The second award is the **Patient Satisfaction Award**, which is presented to wound centers that demonstrate exceptional success by meeting or exceeding a national patient satisfaction benchmark of 96%.
